This workshop will help community and healthcare providers recognize and identify the dynamics of domestic violence; understand the complex impact of domestic violence on individuals, families and the community; and the role community and healthcare providers can play in helping to respond to and prevent domestic violence.

Presenter

Nicole Morella, MA is the Director of Public Policy and Communications for the NJ Coalition to End Domestic Violence. She has worked in the domestic violence field for 18 years providing education and technical assistance to improve community level and systemic responses to domestic violence. In her current role, Ms. Morella strives to elevate the needs and voices of survivors to increase safety for survivors, accountability for offenders, and a strong network of providers. She also works with the Communications Team to elevate the conversation about domestic violence and the role communities can play in preventing domestic and dating violence.

Physicians, midwives, Advance Practice nurses, nurses, social workers, mental health providers providing support for individuals who may have experienced domestic violence.
