This webinar will focus on best practices in screening for domestic violence, available tools, and resources.

Presenter

Gladys Martinez MSW, LCSW, NCTTP worked for several domestic violence shelters throughout New Jersey, eventually becoming Director of Shelter Services for a program in Union County. Ms. Martinez currently works at the University Hospital's Women's Health Clinic, Newark, where she provides assessment and counseling services to women and their families. Additionally she is a co-founder and the current chair of the University Hospital Coalition to End Abuse, whose mission is to raise awareness and train staff, students and the community on domestic violence, sexual assault and human trafficking.

Target Audience

Physicians, midwives, Advance Practice nurses, nurses, social workers, mental health providers providing support for individuals who may have experienced domestic violence.

Learning Outcome

At the conclusion of the program, the participants will self-report knowledge gain related to screening for domestic violence and intent to change practice by including information or tools presented into professional practice.
