## Keys to Preventing Adverse Outcomes in Hyperemesis Gravidarum

Recognizing the warning signs of hyperemesis gravidarum (HG) is essential to establishing timely intervention. Failure to effectively address mothers' physical and psychosocial needs may lead to severe and lasting complications of HG for both mother and child. With appropriate care before severe HG develops, mothers and their children have the greatest chance at a healthy future.

Kimber Wakefield MacGibbon, BSN, RN, is a Registered Nurse and the co-founder of the Hyperemesis Education and Research (HER) Foundation. She has co-authored over 40 publications on HG and developed numerous clinical resources for diagnosing and managing HG. For over 20 years, she has helped many thousands of families navigate the complexities of HG.
